### **Delay Occurrences**

- 13 segments (5 in Oregon) where delay occurrences exceed 50% of trains operated

  - Albany Salem
  - Salem Oregon City ۲
  - Eugene Albany
  - Portland Vancouver, WA

## **Improvements and Opportunities**

## Vancouver, BC Preclearance

- Expected to open in Spring 2025, will be North America's 1st passenger rail pre-clearance facility
- Reduce customs delays, save ~10 minutes on each trip
- **\*** Key Consideration: Spur Canadian investment in corridor





## **New Amtrak Airo Trainsets**

- First new Airo trainsets to be delivered for Amtrak Cascades
- Expected to enter revenue service in mid-2026
- Each train seats 300 passengers
- **\*** Key Consideration: Future of 2 Oregon-owned trainsets

## **Fed Appropriations & Grant Opportunities**

**PNW Rail Improvement Modernization Program** 

- Requested \$100m for PNW improvements from Congress Corridor ID, Fed-State Partnership, CRISI opportunities
- Key Consideration: Federal investment tied to state match
