Sherwood Breaks Ground On New Pedestrian Bridge

Rep. Courtney Neron advocated for state funding to build the pedestrian bridge over Highway 99W at Sunset Blvd.

SHERWOOD, Ore. - Today, **Rep. Courtney Neron (D-Wilsonville)** joined local leaders and members of the community to officially break ground for a new pedestrian bridge over Hwy 99 in Sherwood. In 2021, Neron, an educator, parent, and State Representative for Sherwood, secured \$4 million in state funding to support the project.

"We are breaking ground for a beautiful bridge that will welcome people to Sherwood and connect the community as it continues to grow. Projects like this pedestrian bridge are critical to community connectivity, community safety, and livability," said Neron. "Over the course of multiple legislative sessions, I fought for and secured, in partnership with the City of Sherwood, \$4 million in funding for this project."

The bridge will serve as a trails system connector and create safe passage between Sherwood High School and the YMCA. Neighborhoods and community hubs will benefit from increased walkability.

"I am grateful for Rep. Neron's support in securing funding for our latest project," said **Mayor Tim Rosener of Sherwood**. "This new pedestrian bridge is a testament to our shared commitment to enhancing our community's connectivity and accessibility. The bridge not only spans physical distances but also symbolizes the unity and collaboration that make Sherwood a vibrant and thriving place to live."
