



2025 Legislative Session Take Home's

Community Investments

We secured a **\$5 million** investment in the Happy Valley Community Center which is the final funding the City needs to finish the project. We also secured funding for the Mt. Scott Learning Center and Gresham Fire Station 74.

Education Investments

Chronic Absenteeism

HB 3199 - Creates an attendance advisory committee who will receive recommendations from a study on attendance initiatives in Oregon.

HB 3218 - Study to determine what an expansion of the Tribal Attendance Promising Practices program would need.

SB 315 - Standardizes the common attendance codes districts use.

Other Education Priorities

HB 2007 B - Establishes the summer learning grant program.

HB 2682 - Modernizes funding model for early special education based on current data and needs.

SB 1098 - Prohibits discrimination when selecting/retaining school library materials, textbooks or instructional materials or when developing and implementing a curriculum.

Housing Investments

SB 599 - Prevents Discrimination based on Immigration Status in Real Estate.

HB 3521 A - Protects Renter's Deposits.

HB 3522 - Allows the eviction of a squatter.

HB 3031 - Financial Assistance (Low-interest loans/grants) for affordable housing infrastructure.

SB 51 - Preserve manufactured home communities and publicly supported housing (PuSH).

Strengthening Consumer Protections

SB 465 A - Removes the annual cap on matching funds for IDA holders and creates a cap on total matching funds.

SB 430 B - Requires sellers to show all fees for online goods or services that a buyer must pay.

HB 2008 B - Prohibits personal data from being processed for targeted advertising or sale.

HB 3179 - Public Utility Commission to analyze cumulative impacts of proposed rate increases; prevents utility rate hikes in the winter.

HB 3546 - Focus on large energy users paying their fair share to support usage and transmission; Prevents residential customers from subsidizing the cost of running a data center.

Child Care Caucus Inaugural Wins

HB 2682 - Study to modernize service levels for early intervention in early childhood special education.

HB 3560 A - Expands allowable sites for child care centers.

HB 2008 - Starting in 2026, data for Oregonians younger than 16 cannot be sold; A child cannot be targeted for advertising, or consumer profiling; precise location of child cannot be identified.

SB 692 - OHA will support community-based perinatal services and requires insurers cover for medicaid.



Other Notable "Nguyen's"

Health Care

HB 3064 - Perimenopause, Menopause, Post-Menopause care must be covered by OEBB and PEBB beginning 2026.

HB 2010 - Federal govt slashing Medicaid, not us; OHP Serves 1,400,000 vulnerable Oregonians (⅓ of Oregonians. ⅓ of Oregon's children); These dollars stabilize hospitals (saving lives) and support long term care facilities; Coverage for HIV treatment (HB 2942/2292), Momnibus (SB 690/692), menopause coverage (HB 3064).

Behavioral Health & Safety

HB 3582 - Removed reporting timelines for childhood abuse and sexual assault.

HB 2059 - Secured critically needed investments in expanded behavioral health facilities, including Clackamas Recovery Campus.
