Representative Andy Olson Sworn In For Sixth Term As State Representative

Salem, OR – Today, Representative Andy Olson (R-Albany) was sworn in for a sixth term as state representative for House District 15. Rep. Olson joined his colleagues and family in the House Chamber for the swearing-in ceremony administered by Chief Justice of the Oregon Supreme Court, Thomas A. Balmer.

“I’m humbled to have the opportunity to continue serving the Albany community as state representative,” said Rep. Olson. “This session will provide great opportunities for the legislature to reinforce our public safety system, build a regulatory environment for legalized marijuana, and work with state agencies for improved accountability.”
