2026 Legislative Accomplishments

Building an Oregon that Works for Everyone

Secured investments in local resiliency

- \$3.14 million for Western Oregon University building repair, ensuring students have the space they need to learn
- \$1.35 million for McNary Field resiliency and emergency preparedness capability

Pushed to make life more affordable for Oregon families

- Expanded the Earned Income Tax Credit and set up tax credits to create new jobs (SB 1507)
- Imposed a 90-day waiting period on corporate investors competing to buy single-family homes (HB 4128)
- Invested \$100 million to build and preserve affordable housing (HB 5204)

Passed bills to support health, dignity, and safety for Oregonians

- Removed out-of-pocket costs for cervical cancer screenings (SB 1527)
- Stopped bad actors from taking advantage of hospice patients (SB 1575)
- Invested in building more wheelchair-accessible affordable homes (SB 1576)
- Requires health insurance plans to keep covering scientifically proven vaccines for people who want them (SB 1598)

Protected core services

- Preserved state funding for critical services despite federal cuts (SB 1507)
- Prevented cuts to health care, education, and public safety programs (SB 5703 and HB 5204)
- Made targeted investments to address emergencies across the state

Fought back against federal overreach

- Required law enforcement to be identifiable and unmasked in most situations (HB 4138)
- Stopped data brokers from selling your data to ICE (SB 1587)
- Defended hospitals as places for healing (SB 1570)
- Directed school districts to make plans for what to do when ICE comes on school property (HB 4079)
- Invested in legal services for immigrants and refugees (HB 5204)
