In attempt to comply with <u>Senate Rule 13.02</u>, Oregon Statute <u>ORS 171.134</u>, and <u>Legislative</u> <u>Councils Form and Style Manual</u>, I am submitting the following revised measure summary:

The bill allows the Department of State Lands to deal with property that is left on state lands without authorization. It allows the department to move, store and destroy these items. It also tasks the department's Director to set charges for certain services performed by the department.
