Dear Secretary Brocker and Publications Coordinator Goulding,

Please accept this vote explanation for HB 2634 A to become a permanent entry in the journal:

In attempt to comply with <u>Senate Rule 13.02</u>, Oregon Statute <u>ORS 171.134</u>, and <u>Legislative</u> <u>Councils Form and Style Manual</u>, I am submitting the following revised measure summary:

The bill clarifies that RVs are not covered by the parts of the Landlord and Tenant Act about manufactured dwelling parks. It expands the meaning of "vacation occupancy" to include a stay of up to 90 days at an RV park. It describes landlord or RV park owner rights related disposal of abandoned RVs.

Senate President Robert Wagner has also submitted this redrafted summary in the form of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Reading Measure Digest as a floor letter in an attempt to comply with <u>Senate Rule</u> 13.02, Oregon Statute <u>ORS 171.134</u>, and <u>Legislative Councils Form and Style Manual</u>.
