Dear Secretary Brocker and Publications Coordinator Goulding,

Please accept this vote explanation for HB 3456 B to become a permanent entry in the journal:

In attempt to comply with <u>Senate Rule 13.02</u>, Oregon Statute <u>ORS 171.134</u>, and <u>Legislative</u> <u>Councils Form and Style Manual</u>, I am submitting the following revised measure summary:

The bill directs colleges and universities to survey students and staff about sexual misconduct and to take steps to prevent it. The bill also directs HECC to convene a council to help make the survey. It requires colleges and universities to hire certified staff to help students. It directs them to work with a third party to offer victim services. It requires them to give sexual misconduct training each year. It requires them waive some requirements for students who experience sex misconduct. It directs them to submit a report each year on sexual misconduct.
