In attempt to comply with <u>Senate Rule 13.02</u>, Oregon Statute <u>ORS 171.134</u>, and <u>Legislative</u> Councils Form and Style Manual, I am submitting the following revised measure summary:

The bill prohibits a party from raising certain new issues with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) on appeal. It also allows LUBA to affirm certain decisions in parts.
