I appreciate the work that went into HB 3644 B and the intent to respond to the urgent need for shelter capacity in Oregon. However, I voted no yesterday because I believe our focus should remain on stabilizing people in their homes—through meaningful investments in down payment assistance, eviction prevention, and rental assistance.

Right now, too many Oregonians are just one unexpected expense away from losing their housing. Without reinforcing the systems that keep people housed in the first place, we're spending hundreds of millions on a band-aid for a much deeper wound.

We desperately need to address the housing crisis, but I believe our long-term investments must prioritize permanent housing solutions and upstream supports.
