“SB 221 received a “no” vote today. The bill’s intent as expressed by the Carrier did not match the written text of the word of the law in the bill itself. No idea why. There was no public testimony in OLIS. This State Senator’s experience with legislation presented by the Oregon Law Commission has been untrustworthy to date. Without non-lawyer public testimony overwhelmingly in favor any favored OLC bill will receive a ‘no’ vote in opposition.”
