“SB 112 got a ‘no’ vote on the Floor as the text of the bill and explanation on the Floor of the State Senate did not match. Actually researched the record before the Floor for the definition of ‘common law’ employee yet the definition was not in the bill. Instead, there was a reference to a United States Code which itself changes constantly. Be the Floor explanation, a volunteer or intern working in the Legislature would be considered an employee yet HR and the AG say the opposite. Thus would every member with an intern or volunteer have a conflict of interest. Whether the bill is good or bad is unknown. Hopefully, clarity will be added in the House.”
