

## VOTE EXPLANATION ON SB 614A APRIL 19, 2023

To: Lori L. Brocker, Secretary of the Senate

Dear Secretary Brocker,

For the record, my "No" vote on SB 614A on Tuesday, April 18<sup>th</sup>, was due to concerns I have around the language in Section 1, Subsection 2 (lines 12-13 of the bill), which exempts law enforcement from constraints described in Section 1 in lines 6-8 of the bill, if

"...the information was collected and maintained for any other lawful purpose, including but not limited to, activities carried out in accordance with ORS 133.741."

This language is overly broad in its expansion of the exemption to civil liberties protections and expands the bill past what I understand to be its intended purpose. I believe this subsection should be amended in the House of Representatives to address only the appropriate change in the law within its needed scope.

If these changes are made in the House of Representatives, I would be happy to have the opportunity to support the amended version of SB 614 on concurrence.
