SB 64 is an exact duplicate of SB 438 (2023 Regular Session). In 2023, SB 438 had a fiscal impact statement of \$405,120 for DHS to contract out the work to update the ONE eligibility system for reference table updates, user portal updates and benefit calculation updates. The current SB 64 fiscal analysis states "No fiscal impact" for the exact same legislation.
