HB3093 gets amended with a “fix” to SB 941

Salem - Today an amendment to HB3093 was introduced in an attempt to fix SB941, the background check bill the Governor already signed into law. Rep Bill Post (R-Keizer) is the Chief sponsor of HB 3093 and is deeply disappointed with these tactics.

“HB3093 is a simple, straightforward concealed handgun reciprocity bill, that passed the House 57-1,” Post said. “My bill has nothing to do with background checks and should be allowed a simple vote in the Senate, without being messed with.”

“I sat in on the House Rules committee when they heard the public testimony on SB 941. The proponents of that bill said it was a commonsense solution – why are they now saying it needs to be fixed? Those issues should be addressed in a different bill – not mine, that has nothing to do with background checks. I am a strong supporter of our second amendment rights and I am offended that my bill would be hijacked to forward an alternative agenda.”
