Statement from Rep. Bill Post

Salem, ORE. – Representative Bill Post (R-Keizer) has released the following statement:

“Unfortunately, the supermajority has made it clear they are not interested in any sort of compromise on cap and trade. Thousands of hard-working Oregonians were excluded from the process to have their voices heard. Passing this complex bill should not be forced in a short 35-day legislative session. House Republicans have proposed an alternative option that would bring this policy forward to the voters in the form of a ballot referral, only to be rejected. We are using one of the last tools we have in the minority by denying quorum to ensure this legislation does not move forward. We heard you and we are doing everything we can to protect the livelihoods of Oregonians.”
