### **Judiciary Committees to Conduct Dec. 17 Hearing on Active Shooter Events**

SALEM – Senator Floyd Prozanski (D-Eugene), chair of the Senate Judiciary Committee, announced that the House and Senate Judiciary Committees will meet jointly tomorrow, Thursday, December 17, to provide an opportunity for examination and discussion on the state's role in preventing and responding to violent, active shooter events.

"It is essential for us as legislators to review what has occurred and to consider how we may be better prepared in the future," said Senator Prozanski.

In the wake of the senseless shooting at Umpqua Community College, the hearing will provide the Legislature with an opportunity to look for areas where Oregon can make changes so our homes, schools, and communities are safer. Topics will include threat assessments, prevention efforts, mental health services, on-site security options, coordinated law enforcement responses, and community and victim services.
