Senator Roblan Praises Jordan Cove Energy Project Authorization

COOS BAY—State Senator Arnie Roblan (D-Coos Bay) praised today’s authorization by the U.S. Department of Energy for the Jordan Cove Energy Project in Coos Bay to export domestically-produced liquefied natural gas (LNG).

“The Jordan Cove Energy Project will provide much-needed economic development in the south Oregon coast in general and in Coos Bay in particular. This project will attract new investment, create new, good-paying jobs and will revitalize our coastal communities,” said Senator Roblan. “My community has fought long and hard for this project over the years, and I am thrilled that today it is closer to becoming a reality in my district.”

In writing to President Obama to encourage federal approval of the project, Senator Roblan pointed out that the Jordan Cove Energy Project will help make the United States a net natural gas exporter.

“Without a doubt, the Jordan Cove Project is a win-win-win. It will be good for the people of Coos Bay, good for the people of Oregon, and good for the nation,” said Roblan. “I want to thank Senator Ron Wyden, the Oregon Coastal Caucus, and particularly Representative Caddy McKeown for their persistent efforts to secure this authorization from the Department of Energy.”

Senator Roblan represents Coos Bay in the Oregon Senate, and he represented the area in the Oregon House of Representatives from 2004 to 2012. He lives in Coos Bay with his wife Arlene.
