## New Program to Boost Oregon Small Businesses Passes Oregon Senate

**SALEM, Ore** - Today, the Oregon Senate passed <u>Senate Bill 1048</u>, which directs the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) to establish a small business development program to aid qualified small businesses to compete for ODOT public improvement contracts.

"This bill will make sure that Oregonians' hard earned tax dollars are wisely used to repair our essential transportation infrastructure and boost our small businesses, which will support and create jobs in communities around the state," said **Senator Aaron Woods (D - Wilsonville)**. "Oregon's small businesses are always a smart investment."

Oregon Senate Democrats' <u>2023 Oregon Works agenda</u> prioritizes investing in and growing Oregon small businesses, which support thousands of family-wage jobs around the state.

SB 1048 is one of the hundreds of bills that Senate Democrats rescued by negotiating an end to the Senate Republican walkout.
