### **ADVISORY: Senate Housing Committee to Hold Meeting on September 27th**

*Senators will hear updates on the emergency homelessness response, housing production, and housing infrastructure*

**SALEM, Ore** - On Wednesday, September 27th, 2023, the Senate Interim Committee on Housing and Development will hold a meeting to receive updates on homelessness and affordable housing production in Oregon.

“Oregonians are deeply concerned about the homelessness and affordable housing crisis in our state, and we’re committed to working together to solve these problems. Our committee made tremendous progress in the 2023 legislative session. Now, we need to make sure the policies we passed and investments we made are delivering results, while continuing to identify any gaps that need to be closed,” said **Senator Kayse Jama (D - Portland)**, chair of the committee.

Invited speakers at the meeting will provide information about the Governor’s emergency homelessness response and housing production advisory council, the implementation status of the [bipartisan legislation on homelessness and affordable housing](#) passed in 2023, and cities’ infrastructure needs to support more housing.
