Majority Leader welcomes Rob Wagner to Oregon Senate

Clackamas, Multnomah and Washington county commissioners make appointment for Senate District 19 seat vacated by Sen. Richard Devlin

SALEM – The Clackamas, Multnomah and Washington county commissioners today appointed Rob Wagner, of Lake Oswego, to the Oregon Senate. Wagner will fill the seat vacated when Sen. Richard Devlin, D-Tualatin, resigned early this year.

In response, Senate Majority Leader Ginny Burdick, D-Portland, made the following statement:

"We are excited to welcome Rob Wagner to the Oregon Senate. As a product of Oregon Schools, and as a community college administrator who also has worked for the American Federation of Teachers of Oregon, he knows education. As a former legislative staff member and advocate, he knows the legislative process. I am excited to work with him as a colleague. The opening of our next Legislative Session is right around the corner, and I'm confident Rob is ready to hit the ground running."

Wagner was one of three nominees selected by representatives of the Clackamas, Multnomah and Washington county Democratic Party central committees and put forth to the commissioners of all three counties for potential appointment. Wagner will finish out the remainder of the current term in the seat vacated by Devlin, who resigned after his appointment to the Northwest Power and Conservation Council.
