Oregon Senate Democrats Commit to Economic Growth that Extends to All Oregonians, Not Just the Richest

SALEM, Ore. – Oregon’s Office of Economic Analysis this morning presented an economic and revenue forecast for the state. **Senate Majority Leader Kayse Jama (D – E Portland, Damascus & Boring)** responds with the following statement:

“Beneath the surface of the latest forecast is a hard truth: even as Oregon’s economy grows, too many working families are being left behind. Income for wealthy investors is rapidly rising while working families’ paychecks are not keeping up.
