HB 3427 would provide stable, dedicated funding source for Oregon's classrooms

SALEM – Senate Majority Leader Ginny Burdick (D-Portland) issued the following statement regarding Senate Republicans' refusal to work, holding up a bill that will dramatically improve Oregon's education system:
