Annual session referral scheduled for public hearing & work session

Senate rules committee will hear testimony on referral to voters

SALEM—The Senate Rules Committee will hold a public hearing and work session on Senate Joint Resolution 41 Monday morning at 9 AM. Legislators, public interest advocates, and members of the Public Commission on the Legislature are expected to testify on the bill.

SJR 41 would refer to voters a constitutional amendment establishing fixed-length, annual sessions for the state. The Legislature would meet for approximately 135 days in odd-numbered years and 45 days in even-numbered years.
