Committee to hear from consumers on ‘free’ trial and promotional offers *Misleading offers can leave consumers on the hook for monthly payments*

SALEM – Members of the Senate Interim Committee on Consumer Protection and Public Affairs will hear testimony tomorrow from citizens who have been taken advantage of by misleading “free trial” and promotional offers. Consumers are sometimes lured into these schemes with the promise of a free sample product and may subsequently be left with a monthly credit card charge for a completely unrelated product.
