"Does this look 'peaceful'?" Senate Republican Leader Points to Violence in Portland Riots

SALEM, Ore. – Today marks another day in Oregon after a night of violence in Portland.

"Democrats have made it very clear that they are the party of lawlessness and stand with violence," said Senate Republican Leader Fred Girod (R-Stayton). "Federal, state and local Democrats continue to defend blatantly violent actions by anarchists by calling them 'peaceful'.

"I have to ask Oregonians: Does this snapshot of what's really going on in Portland look 'peaceful'?"

- 1. Portland Police Association (PPA) arson
- 2. Federal officer assaulted while making an arrest during a riot
- 3. Lasers, glass bottles, paint, rocks and ball bearings thrown at officers
- 4. Federal officers in Portland may have been permanently blinded by lasers
- 5. Fireworks launched at the Justice Center
- 6. Innocent Oregonians are suffering
- 7. Portland business owners call on city to stop violence

Senator Girod continued, "I have said this before and will say it again: the violent anarchists have completely undermined the efforts of peaceful protests in Portland."
