Bureaucracy and Spin Won't Fix Oregon's Problems

SALEM, Ore. – Senator Christine Drazan (R-Canby), Vice-Chair of the Senate Committee on Commerce and General Government, responded today to **Governor Tina Kotek's** new so-called "Prosperity Roadmap".

"Let's remember this is the same leader who helped drive Oregon's economy into decline. For more than a decade—from the Speaker's chair to the Governor's office—Tina Kotek has pushed the policies that wrecked our economy: the <u>largest tax increase</u> in state history, her green-energy <u>regulatory scheme</u>, a <u>\$4.3 billion</u> transportation tax hike, and policies that <u>legalized</u> tent cities.
