Roseburg Veteran’s Home Legislation Moves Forward in the Last Hours of the ’18 Short Session

SALEM – Legislation that directs the Director of Veterans’ Affairs to move forward with the progression of the establishment of the Roseburg Oregon Veterans’ Home, and setting aside over \$10 million dollars of funding for this important project, passes the Oregon House of Representatives.

Former State Representative and current Douglas County Commissioner Tim Freeman first introduced this important legislation while he was a member of the Oregon House of Representatives. “This legislation is as important to me now, as it was when I originally moved it forward while serving in the Legislature,” said Commissioner Freeman. “I applaud the efforts of my colleagues on this needed progress and for insuring the related funding that was secured is still allocated to the project.” The Roseburg Veterans’ Home would serve Veterans’ of Southwest Oregon and across the State. The Douglas County Commission supports this needed project in Roseburg and the positive impact it will bring to the region as a whole. “It is an honor to serve our Veterans and sponsor this and other programs and services that provide needed support to our Veterans’ community and their families,” said Douglas County Commissioner Chris Boice. “We must continue to move forward on this and other Veteran service projects and I thank Commissioner Freeman and all involved for their support of our Veterans.”

The Roseburg Oregon Veterans’ Home would place key Veteran services in Southwest Oregon.
