Representative-Elect Duane Stark Appointed to 2015 Legislative Committees
Freshman Legislator Named Vice Chair of Human Services and Housing Committee

Salem, OR – Representative-Elect Duane Stark (R-Grants Pass) was selected by House Speaker Tina Kotek to serve as a member of the following committees during the 78th Legislative Assembly:

- Human Services and Housing Committee, Vice Chair
- Consumer Protection and Government Effectiveness Committee
- Joint Human Services Subcommittee

As Vice Chair of the Human Services and Housing Committee, Rep-Elect Stark will be a champion for Oregon's most vulnerable citizens, while also maintaining a focus on efficiency and fraud prevention within state agencies.

"Building effective coalitions between businesses, non-profits and local governments will be one of my top priorities," said Rep-Elect Stark. "I look forward to working with my colleagues to pursue human services reforms that maximize benefits for vulnerable Oregonians, develop economic policies that benefit rural communities and advocate for strong public safety laws that protect our communities and families."

Rep-Elect Stark will be sworn in for his first term as a member of the Oregon House of Representatives on January 12, 2015. He will represent House District 4, which includes the communities of Central Point, White City, Eagle Point, Gold Hill, Rogue River and portions of Grants Pass.
