REPRESENTATIVES DAVIS & THATCHER HOST LIVE TELEPHONE & TWITTER TOWN HALL MAY 29TH

SALEM, OR – [State Representative John Davis](#) (R-Wilsonville) and [Representative Kim Thatcher](#) (R-Keizer, Newberg and St. Paul) will host a live Telephone and Twitter Town Hall May 29th to discuss key legislation from the 2014 session, and hot issues in the 2015 session. The event will include an overview of the State Revenue Forecast from special guest Mark McMullen, State Economist and head of the Oregon Office of Economic Analysis.

In addition, a special guest has been invited to discuss updated information for Cover Oregon and the transition to the federal healthcare exchange.

The town hall will take place on Thursday, **May 29^h from 6:30pm-7:30pm** at the Oregon State Capitol during May Legislative Days and constituents will be able to participate by calling in by phone or asking questions via twitter and Facebook.

Representative Thatcher and I both have large, diverse districts, and we realize that evening town halls can be difficult to attend. This is a chance to learn about our state without having to travel,” commented Representative Davis on the event.
