SALEM, Ore.-A bipartisan group of legislators, and community and education leaders, expressing support for Measure 98, will be hosting a press conference at the Statehouse Mon. Mar. 13 from 1:00 to 1:30 PM PT. A Roseburg High School student and a CTE educator will give a computer design and 3D-printing demonstration at noon in the Senate Majority Office.
