Economic Forecast Shows Federal Policies Continue to Hurt Oregon

Tariffs, economic uncertainty, and cuts to vital programs are worsening Oregon's economic outlook and the state's ability to provide needed services

SALEM, Ore. – Today, the Oregon Office of Economic Analysis released and presented to state legislators its most recent revenue forecast and economic outlook.

Senate President Rob Wagner (D-Lake Oswego) is releasing the following statement:

"It is now increasingly clear — on top of tariffs and economic uncertainty, the Trump administration's signature piece of legislation will hurt everyday Oregonians and harm the state's ability to provide needed public services. There is a lot of work ahead of us. We need to pull together to invest in Oregon's infrastructure and economy, continue to support vital public services, and protect Oregonians from the chaos of the federal administration."
