Legislature to Host Peter Courtney Celebration of Life

SALEM, Ore. – The Oregon Legislature will host a celebration of life for the late Peter Courtney on January 29, 2025, at 2 p.m. The event will be held in the Senate chamber and simulcast in the House of Representatives. The Senate will be held for reserved seating only, while the House will be open seating. There will be additional overflow seating available elsewhere in the Capitol.
