Representative Carl Wilson Rejoins Oregon House of Representatives

Salem, OR – In a ceremony administered by the Chief Justice of the Oregon Supreme Court, Thomas A. Balmer, Representative Carl Wilson was sworn in today as state representative for House District 3.

“I’m honored to be returning to the legislature and to have the opportunity to serve the people of House District 3,” said Rep. Wilson. “I look forward to working with my colleagues to advance education reform, develop a responsible regulatory environment for legalized marijuana, and deliver an improved quality of life for rural Oregonians.”

As a member of the 78th Assembly of the Oregon Legislature, Rep. Wilson will serve on the following committees:

- Joint Committee on Implementing Measure 91, Vice Chair
- Rules Committee
- Education Committee

In addition to his regular legislative duties, Rep. Wilson will serve as Deputy Leader of the House Republican Caucus.

Rep. Wilson previously served in the Oregon House of Representatives from 1998-2002. House District 3 covers most of Josephine County and includes the Grants Pass and Illinois Valley communities. He and his wife Malinda live in Grants Pass and have two adult children. Rep. Wilson’s legislative office will be staffed by his Chief of Staff Michelle Binker and Legislative Assistant Tara Laughlin.
